

Barony of Trughanacney Triocha = centred, quartered Aicne = Tribe, group
CASTLE ISLAND

- 1226 Castle built by Geoffrey De Marisco (Strongbow's nephew 218)
- 1236 Gave castle to Fitzgerald as part of dowry.
- Before (Evelyn H.) St Finian's Church in use
- 1231 Letter from Henry 3 To The Constable of Castle Island To the effect that "William Marshall, Earl of Pembroke, your Liege Lord is dead. Freely deliver up Castle Island To Waterford Featon to whose keeping we have committed the castle + lands."
- 1250 Dominican nuns Kilbarron Lived in St. Stephen's Church
- 1329 Maurice Fitzgerald created first Earl of Desmond (Chambers Biographical)
- 1345 Castle captured by Sir Ralph Ussher, Lord Justice of Ireland.
Castle held for Maurice FitzThomas Fitzgerald, 1st Earl, by Sir Eustace de Pieri, Sir William Grait, Sir John Coterel.
- 1397 Gerald The Poet, 4th Earl, murdered near the castle. (75)
- 1422 Indenture between Lord James Fitzgerald, Earl of Desmond and (13) Walter Fitzmaurice FitzThomas To answer the said earl + his heirs in their appointment + levies
- 1534 Gerald, 9th Earl of Kildare, died in Tower of London (Chambers)
- 1537 Silken Thomas, 10th Earl of Kildare, hanged drawn + quartered with his 5 uncles at Tyburn Hill. (Chambers)
End of the Kildare Geraldines.
- 1570 (14) 4 Masters record that the valley of the Maine was wasted by the Earl of Ormonde (Black Earl) without opposition because the 2 Desmonds were then in prison in London
- 1579-80 Gerald the 15th Earl sacked Youghal (Chambers)
- 1579 Massacre at Derry or Oir.
- 1583 (1575) (40) RH 48-52 679 139-141 Gerald, 16th Earl of Desmond, killed at Cileanogeerty
- 1589c Plantation of Munster RH 58-60
- 16 Cromwellian Plantation
Down Survey William Petty
- Sir William Herbert of Monmouth 73 { Lord of the Island Castle
Lord Herbert of Cherbury his son in law.
41. 6 Undertakers from Ballyragget to Clondraugh and from Mountagle to the foot of Slieve Mish.
One of the 6 afterwards sold his share to the founder of Melville, Dicksgrove.
- 41 Each of the 6 had a share in the old Market House

Dineen = 1 centred (at $\frac{1}{2}$ cart Onan.)
Triocha céad = 30 hundreds of land
= 30 baile biaidhTaigh
= 3,600 quarters
= $\frac{1}{30}$ of a cíce

 $= \frac{1}{30}$ of a barony
= 480 Irish Acres
