- TMD 180
~~Not True~~ The market house was built by the descendants of the 6 Undertakers
- 180 (1870c) The market house, ¹⁹³⁰ now the Emporium, had 3 institutions housed within its great walls.
1. The central portion was the market proper where farm produce of all kinds was weighed, bought + sold.
- 3 huge gates fronted the main street
- TMD 181 On the left, as you entered the Market House, was the local dispensary, where Dr. Nolan and his assistant dispenser Mr. Thomas Burke, attended to the wants of the sick poor
