- 11 John o Sullivan (The bard) leader of The moonlighters
 John Twiss hanged in Cork 9 Feb 1895. Jas. Billington 20 hangman
 James Donovan Glenlara 3 miles N.W. Newmarket 21 Apr. 1894
 Bailiff Property Defence Association (East of Cork)
- 23 Thursday April 6 John Twiss arrested. Small man.
- 24 Palatine. Settled in West Lineick.
 Grand. father Robert a gentleman farmer, Mother a Chute.
 Born c. 1860 in London
 Brother William went to Australia from London - became RC priest?
 Sister Mary to U.S.A. John, Jane, George went to Condal.
 George had emigrated to U.S.A.
- 26 Death in the 35th year of life. No strage to RIC in 3 counties
 From his mother he inherited the tolls of Curans + Clisland ~~cotts~~
 Caretaker of graveyards in Kilmurry + Kiltranamun.
- 27 1879 Sept. destroyed hay + cart of o'Rourke. 1 month in jail
 1880 24 June. £3 for bread of the game laws (Then 20)
 Subscription list oversubscribed.
 1881 Xmas night. Moonlighting. 18 months in jail.
 5 1/2 years before he was again to go to jail.
 Captured at Cogh for stealing at Mrs. Larkin who failed to identify.
 Fines for gaming on Ventry estate.
 Sent to prison for carrying out armed raid on John Keefle
 of Knockdown + taking a revolver.
- 31 Eugene o Keefle received a letter re raid on 21 Apr. 1894
 Told brother John.
- 33 Twiss remanded Apr. 27 May 4 May 9 (day Eugene o Keefle was
 arrested. Used to give bay ridings 45)
 Both returned for trial in July.
- 34 Son recognized o Keefle as the hit man. Other man was Twiss
- 42 Mr. Fitzgibbon, Newmarket, sold for Twiss.
- 51 Cornelius Foley itinerant pedlar, identified o Keefle.
- 79 John Brennan Castleisland, had Marshall's gun revolver.
 Twiss asked for loan of gun - going into Co. Cork hunting.
 money porter (living in Dublin)
- 84 Mr. Lyons Tour - knew him 12 years ago when he came for
 blackening when he was going to beat Pat Carver,
 gamekeeper for Lord Cork
- 86 Edward Boyle - Twiss' house 3/4 ml. from his.
- 90 Peter Sugrue, lab, lived next door to Twiss. David o Connell 2 mile
 Anne Irwin - boys had row. Bloodmarks on Joe Twiss.
 Bribery. 250 attempts by Inspector Irwin RIC
- 100 Verdict - Guilty
- 105 I was a moonlighter + suffered for it on 2 occasions.
- 106 Boyle, after shooting a respectable man - shot one policeman.
- 107 Coursey near Brosna. 2 policemen drunk. Woman in Raymond
 Groves
- 109 Death before dishonour.
 Chief Baron Pallas.
- 127 Weight. Going to prison 11st. Execution 12st. 12 lbs.
- 131 Age. Governor - 34 I believe.
- 153 Mrs. Lyons - shooting of a gamekeeper named Culloty
 with which Twiss was not until then connected
- 158 Lyons served under the British flag
 was a member of The North Cork Militia
- 160 I am not Bardar Billy (Hayes) Rock of Gibraltar 1910
 I am Lyons The Newmarket witness.
