Died by 1874 Savage + Power (Cannon's) followed Thompson 1945 John Kellher 1935 bought Freehold. Deeds now in residence.

Before the 1880s Deed Brennan was farming the land.

By the 1870s a near relative Mr. Hickson, Bought by the Kentans early this century.
