School now closed for more than 2 months

13 Apr 1833 Rev. B. Drew Over 100 on books

70-80 boys in daily attendance

30 daily attend in girls schools

98 Arthur H. Saunders
closure causing a great loss to the poor of Castlesland and the neighbourhood
