29 Jan 1833 5 Amount of subscription stated by Rev Browning Drew to be so low that unless some aid be given the managers must from necessity place it under the protection of some other society

11 May 1833 7 Rev. A. Herbert says that they can afford to give £20 p.a. and a good house to a master.

13 April 1833 6 Rev B. Drew - Gratuity not delivered to William Scollard, his conduct being considered by the management as not deserving of it.

17 May 1833 8 Rev. A. Herbert states that, owing to a misunderstanding, he made no effort to look for a teacher. Entreats K.P.S. to send a proper master without delay. School now closed for more than 2 months. *Great loss to poor*

11 Apr. 1842 10 Rev. Fr. R. Mansell objects to establishment of a National school in Castleisland, because he is opposed to principles of National Board and fears K.P.S. school, under his supervision, would be deserted.

Report 12 Nov 1849 11 Applies successfully for connection with National with National Board, opposed by Catholic clergy, school being 250 near an existing National school.
 1849 12 Connected with National Board as Castleisland N.S. No. 2 (Salary granted from 1 Oct. 1848) → N.S. register

1843 1851 13 Taken into connection with National Board on 16 Jan 1851
 Salary Granted from 1 June 1850
